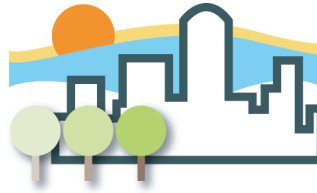

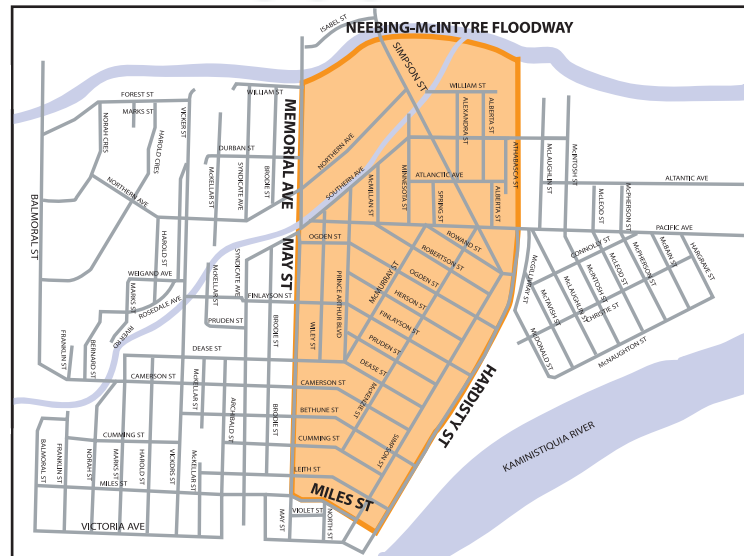
Action for Neighbourhood Change (ANC)
